most of our eight Standing Committees listed in our by-laws.

- 1.Legislative-Political Com**mittee** to inform the membership of political issues of importance to working people (think SB 5 and "so called right to work" legislation.
- 2.Training/Education Committee to present educational programs to the membership
- **3.**Community Outreach and **Engagement Team** to assist in de-



veloping all Community Services Programs.

**4.**Equity Committee responsible for developing and promoting the CWA Civil Rights program.

5. Election Commit**tee** to oversee all elections held by the Local.

6. Facility/Finance Committee to work at the direction of the executive board and be responsible for reviewing the local's financial records, vouchers, audits and budgets at least bi-monthly.
